

Immediately after his baptism, Jesus went into the desert. His 40 day retreat was punctuated by three assaults from the devil. The devil sets a trap and sets Jesus up for disaster. "Just worship me and all this world will be yours," the evil one tells Jesus, "You can have it all. Why just give me

my due Jesus, and everything I have in this world will be yours! You deserve it—you can have it!" Our Lord resists this come on and tells the Devil, in so many words to go to hell!

Our magazines, our newspapers, our radios and televisions are full of advertisements. We are told to buy automobiles, clothing, insurance, computers, toys and everything else that the most productive economic culture in the history of the world can produce. And it can be a big trap! Our credit cards are stressed and our homes have second mortgages. Family paychecks have to pay for two vehicles and a slug of other things that have been sold to us because "we deserve them" or "we have to have them."

Real stewardship is a lot more than just financially supporting our congregation. Christian Stewardship teaches us that God is concerned about all of what we have, not just the dollars we put in the offering plate. Can we help our people to live in such a way as to allow us all to give 10% of our income to God's work, save 10% of our income for our futures and live on the remaining 80%? Unless we as a church confront our common obsession to buy, consume and spend we will spend a lifetime in a great financial trap. And worse we will have set an even bigger trap for our children.
