ELCA CHURCH COUNCIL --- NOMINATIONS

Room at the Inn

Room at the Inn is an emergency homeless shelter which moves from church to church on a weekly basis, and is open from the end of September to the end of May.

We serve about 15 - 20 guests each night. We receive our support from churches, from other groups, and from individuals. We do not accept or solicit donations from any governmental agencies.

Sneaky Visitor Initiative
