## Thank you to all who participated in the Synod Self Study!

The next step begins a "Pre-Identification Process".

Any member of our Northern Great Lakes Synod congregations may submit the name of any ordained minister in the whole of the ELCA as a possibility.

An Identification Form will be posted on the Synod website from April 1 - 15th for you to use to identify any ordained minister that you believe has the ability and potential to serve as the Bishop of our Synod.

The individual identified will be contacted by a member of the Transition Team to make sure they want to proceed and be pre-identified. If the individual agrees to proceed, they will be provided with the Job Description for Synod bishop, the Biographical Information Form, and the link to provide a background check.

#### Timeline:

By April 1 - The Self-Study Report and/or a Summary of the

report will be made available on the Synod website for everyone to read.

- <u>April 1-15</u> Identification of individuals for participation in the Pre-ID Process.
- <u>April 25</u> Deadline for returning to the Synod Office all Biographical Information and Background Check forms from identified individuals.
- May 1 A picture and all biographical information for all preidentified individuals will be posted on the website.

May 21-23 - Synod Assembly and the bishop's election.

We hope you will continue to pray about who our next Synod bishop will be. We encourage all of you to use this Pre-Identification Process to lift up individuals who may serve us well as our next bishop.
