The results of the Synod self Study are posted and available on the Synod website.

The "Pre-Identification Process" is April 1-15.

Any member of our Northern Great Lakes Synod congregations may submit the

name of any ordained minister in the whole of the ELCA as a possibility.

Go to <u>www.nglsynod.org</u> to complete and submit a form that names an ordained minister of the ELCA as one that you would like to be considered as a possibility to serve as Bishop. Any member of our Northern Great Lakes Synod congregations may submit a name.

The individual identified will be contacted by a member of the Transition Team to make sure they want to proceed and be pre-identified. If the individual agrees to proceed, they will be provided with the Job Description for Synod bishop, the Biographical Information Form, and the link to provide a background check.

Timeline:

<u>April 1-15</u> -	Identification of individuals for participation in the Pre-ID Process.
<u>April 25</u> -	Deadline for returning to the Synod Office all Biographical Information and Background Check forms from identified individuals.
<u>May 1</u> -	A picture and all biographical information for all pre- identified individuals will be posted on the website.
<u>May 21-23</u> -	Synod Assembly and the bishop's election.

Please continue to pray about who our next Synod bishop will be. We encourage all of you to use this Pre-Identification Process to lift up individuals who may serve us well as our next bishop.


Big Bear Award and Bread Basket Award

Do you know a congregation that has excelled in their efforts to raise funds for World Hunger? Please nominate an individual for the Bread Basket Award, or




a Congregation for the Big Bear Award.
