Following are pictures and short descriptions of the campaigns carried out to raise money for the fight against World Hunger since 2006.



Global Barnyard

Each animal had its own set value!

As money was donated, animals were made by the committee and placed on the Cry Room window at the back of the church building.





FLOWER GARDEN

(Labor Intensive)

A heavy rope is coiled at the bottom of the altar. Attached to it is a light rope up which is hung vertically through a screw eye at the top of the space you will be using. Tack down.

Pin one flower to the heavy rope for each dollar that is donated. Pull the heavy rope up by pulling the lighter rope down.

Paper Chain

One paper link represents \$1.00 taken in for World Hunger.

Chains are made in 10 link sections by the Sunday School children. They are assembled and hung by the committee.



Water Drops for Hunger

One water drop represents \$1.00 for world hunger.

The Hunger Committee pre-assembled strings of water drops in \$5.00 groups. These strings were hung from the ceiling as money was donated.



MALARIA CAMPAIGN

The Committee hung 2000 mosquitoes from the church ceiling. One was taken down for each dollar donated.

The campaign raised over \$17,000 to fight malaria!!



COMMUNITY GARDEN

Paper cut-outs of fruits and veggies were hung from the ceiling (one for each dollar donated).



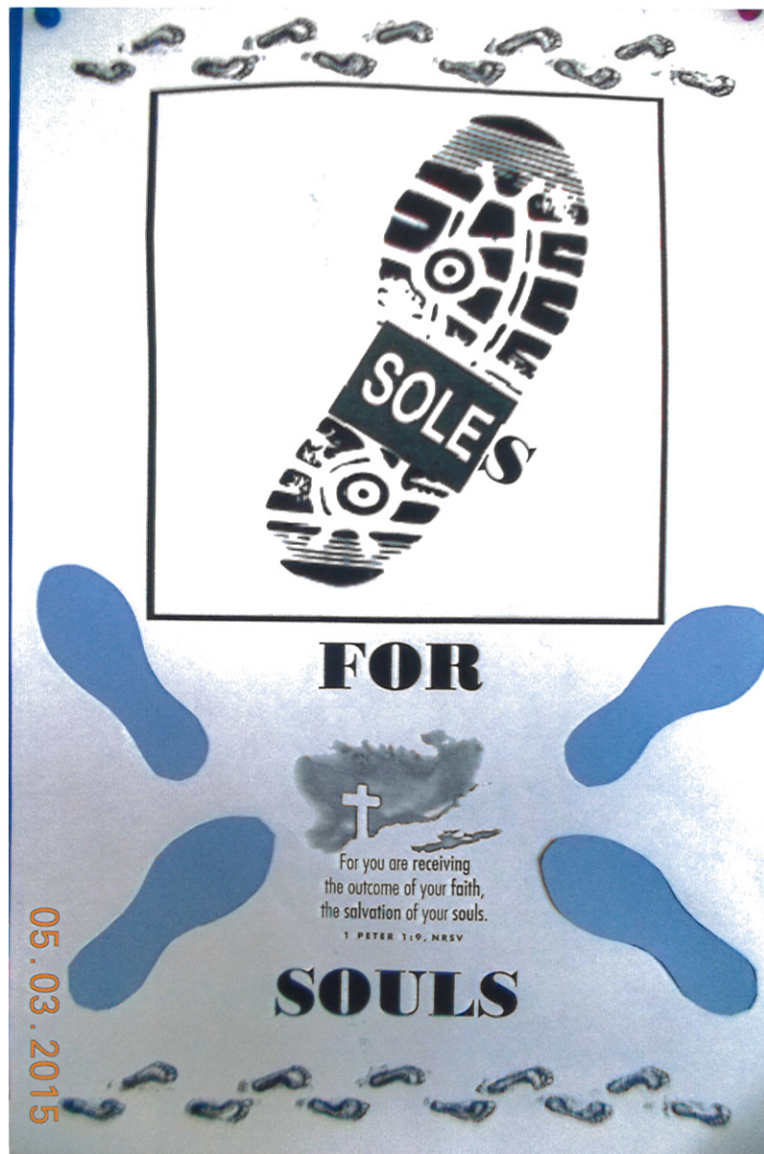
BUCK-A-CHICK

The Committee cut out chicks from a pattern provided by the ELCA World Hunger resources.

The Sunday School children colored the chicks.

One chick was hung from the ceiling for each \$1 donated.





SOLES FOR SOULS

Sole cut-outs were placed around the church building for each dollar given in the fight against hunger.
