he cannot be exhausted by our ideas about him, but he is everywhere suggested.


He cannot be comprehended, but he can be touched.

Did you know...


The Bishop was invited by Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton to attend a Retreat of Newly Elected Leaders sponsored by the Lutheran World Federation. From November 17 – 27, the Bishop spent time in Geneva, Switzerland and Wittenberg, Germany, along with 11 other Lutheran bishops from all over the world; Guyana, Angola, Chile, Hungary, Poland, India, Mexico, Canada, the Florida-Bahamas Synod of the ELCA, and Tanzania. She learned about the impressive work of the Lutheran World Federation and the efforts in ministry in very different settings. Many of our struggles and challenges are similar. Many are as unique and distinctive as the setting.
