# Northern Great Lakes Synod World Hunger Quilt on Display

The World Hunger quilt created in 2018 for our synod Hunger Drive will be on display in the atrium of the Marquette Medical Center in the month of October. Our theme that year was, "All in for World Hunger," and the quilt represents the work of all 82 congregations in the synod at the time. The design was created by Jackie Lehto, a professional quilter and member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Florence, Wisconsin. The back of each of the pieces tells which congregation contributed that square. It was a lot of work, and one of our most successful synod World Hunger fundraisers.
