### **ELCA Domestic Hunger Grants**

A round of Daily Bread Matching Grants will take place this summer, creating opportunities for congregational feeding ministries to build sustainability through generosity and resources within their own communities. ELCA congregations with feeding ministries are eligible to participate, regardless of whether or not they have received a Daily Bread Matching Grant in the past. ## **Loan Debt Forgiveness**

Public Service Loan Forgiveness is a program designed to forgive remaining balance of student debt after 120 payments have been made. Rostered Ministers and employees of non-profits may qualify for this program. However, this is only available through October 31, 2022. Click here to read more about this federal program.
