Indian Boarding Schools: Truth-Seeking & Truth-Telling in the ELCA

The ELCA is beginning a coordinated effort to research Lutheran involvement in Indian boarding and day schools dating back to the 1820's. We are seeking both clergy and lay people who want to be part of this initiative. All are welcome, with a particular need for people with skills in research, data collection, organizing, and education. The goal is for our church members to know the history of church-sponsored Indian boarding schools and their devastating impacts on Native communities, and to participate in an ongoing truth and healing process. Grant Opportunity for Michigan Congregations

The Climate Witness Project of World Renew and the Christian Reformed Church has launched a project called the Sacred Spaces Clean Energy Grant that enables low-income congregations of all faiths in Michigan to become energy efficient and to acquire solar energy. The project will make grants of \$100,000 for energy efficiency to ten low-income congregations and arrange for them to access solar energy.
