Word of the Day

"What's the best method for listening? The method you use to listen well is entirely up to you. Some churches in our study utilize the power of detailed surveys. Others rely primarily on one-on-one conversations or focus groups. Another church holds a newcomers' dinner in which the pastor hosts a meal in her home twice per month. Recent visitors are invited alongside long-standing members to share stories and perceptions of the church. Try one of these methods or experiment with your own even better ideas to see what works well for your congregation."




